Our Grand “*Let the Good Times Roll*” Tour

DAY 1 HOME - NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA Our “Crescent City Tour” (so-named because of its location along the “crescent” banks of the Mississippi River) will be our home for four glorious nights as **we experience an in-depth look** at the heart and soul of the sights, the sounds, the color and the culture that is New Orleans. And how better to “get in the spirit” of this city than with a **Get-Acquainted Dinner Party on Bourbon Street** (included, of course), in the heart of the French Quarter, or as referred to by the locals, *Vieux Carre*? **Welcome to our Grand Tour of New Orleans!**

DAYS 2 - 4 NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA This city really *does* have it all: **French Quarter, Mississippi River, Bourbon Street, French Market, Jackson Square, St. Louis Cathedral, Preservation Hall** (live jazz concerts nightly), **Café Du Monde, Riverwalk Galleria, Superdome**, not to mention streetcars, cemeteries where gravesites are above ground, Ghost/Haunted/Voodoo Tours, and even Harrah’s Hotel & Casino on Canal Street. **SIT BACK AND ENJOY** a fully narrated “**New Orleans City/Cemetery/Garden District (highlights) Tour** (marvel at the historic Victorian mansions along St. Charles Avenue). **Katrina** (just one more incredible part of New Orleans’ history): What happened in August 2005; why did the levee system fail; what was affected; who was affected; what has happened since; and most importantly, how are the people affected by the “costliest tropical hurricane in U.S. history” (\$81.5 billion 2005 dollars) managing several years later? Our tour also includes a **Mississippi River Steamboat Dinner Jazz Cruise** and an **Alligator Swamp Boat Tour**.

DAY 5 NEW ORLEANS - HOME Yes, it is time to “head home” but not before we experience one more incredible part of New Orleans’ history: a visit to the **National World War II Museum**, including a showing of “*Beyond All Boundaries*” in the **Victory Theatre 4-D Cinematic Experience**, introduced by actor Tom Hanks. By mid-afternoon we will return back to **Louis Armstrong Airport** in New Orleans for our return flight home. *What an incredible city . . . what an incredible tour . .*
