# ALASKA GRAND INTERIOR TOUR

**MAY 17, 2019 through MAY 26, 2019**

**DAY 1 HOME -- ANCHORAGE** Fly to Anchorage to begin your “Once in a Lifetime” discovery of The Last Frontier. Local tour guide/escort will meet at your hotel following your arrival in Alaska. *Lodging: ANCHORAGE.*

**DAY 2 ANCHORAGE - VALDEZ** After breakfast, board our deluxe motorcoach for today’s adventure to Valdez. Drive through the Matanuska Valley (where they grow monster-sized vegetables in the 24-hour daylight) and visit the town of Palmer, home of the Alaska State Fair. Stop by to photograph Worthington Glacier, a gigantic piece of ice. By late afternoon we arrive in Valdez, comfortably nestled between the waterfront and mountains, giving it the nickname, “Alaska’s Little Switzerland”. *Lodging: VALDEZ (Breakfast)*

**DAY 3 VALDEZ – CRUISE PRINCE WILLIAM SOUND - VALDEZ** Valdez Museum included. You may want to take in an optional activity, such as sea kayaking (why not?), flightseeing high above Columbia Glacier, or maybe a tour of the Pipeline. This afternoon, cruise through the majestic Prince William Sound and explore the three-mile face of the mighty Columbia Glacier. Keep your eyes open for seals, sea lions, otters, whales, dolphins and puffins throughout this delightful exploration cruise. *Overnight: VALDEZ (Breakfast & Lunch on boat)*

**DAY 4 VALDEZ – WRANGELL-ST. ELIAS NATIONAL PARK - FAIRBANKS** This morning we board our motorcoach for the drive north to Fairbanks. The route takes us along the Wrangell-St. Elias National Park, the largest park in the U.S. and along the Trans-Alaskan Pipeline that runs 800 miles from Prudhoe Bay to Valdez. Along the way, hear tales of an Alaska long ago. *Lodging: FAIRBANKS (Breakfast)*

**DAY 5 FAIRBANKS – CHENA RIVER STERNWHEELER CRUISE - FAIRBANKS** This morning we will learn how the gold rush affected Alaska’s interior on a city sightseeing adventure of Fairbanks, and a visit to the Museum of the North. Time is available for shopping, walking, or dining on you own in the downtown area. Later, we cruise along the Chena River aboard the grand sternwheeler “Riverboat Discovery III.” During our cruise, we’ll learn about Alaska Native culture on a tour of an Athabaskan Indian village, hear a professional racer discuss dog mushing, and see a bush pilot take off and land. This evening, maybe an optional trip to Alaska Land for salmon bake dinner (halibut too, of course). *(Breakfast)*

**DAY 6 FAIRBANKS – DENALI NATIONAL PARK** Today we’ll ride our motorcoach along the Parks Highway to Denali National Park. Travel through the rural community of Nenana, known for its river festivals and the Nenana Ice Classic. Afternoon free in Denali Park (optional activities available: Park programs, hiking, rafting, helicopter tours, visit to Iditarod dog kennels or the Denali Dinner Theatre). *Lodging: DENALI NATIONAL PARK (Breakfast)*

**DAY 7 DENALI NATIONAL PARK ALL DAY TOUR** Today we travel deep into Denali National Park on the Tundra Wildlife Tour and search the pristine wilderness for bear, moose, caribou and sheep. This tour is approximately eight hours and includes a snack. *Lodging: DENALI NATIONAL PARK. (Break & Snack)*

**DAY 8 DENALI NATIONAL PARK – TALKEETNA - ALASKA RAILROAD - ANCHORAGE** Breakfast will be included this morning. Today we first travel via motorcoach to the climbing town of Talkeetna. Watch for a glimpse of the majestic Mt. McKinley (recently renamed to Denali) or black bear along the banks of the Susitna River. Enjoy time on your own to explore this quaint Alaskan town. This afternoon our journey continues south to Anchorage by rail in Deluxe Dome Railcars. *Lodging: ANCHORAGE (Breakfast)*

**DAY 9 ANCHORAGE ALL DAY** We’ll enjoy a morning sightseeing tour of Anchorage. Highlights include a visit to the Alaska Native Heritage Center (an interpretive center featuring native cultures), beautiful Lake Hood, the busiest floatplane in the world, and the history of the downtown area. Afternoon at leisure. **Tonight, feast on an Alaskan style meal & compare notes with your traveling companions.** *Lodging: ANCHORAGE (Breakfast & Dinner)*

**DAY 10 ANCHORAGE - HOME** No, our tour can’t be over yet! Yes, unfortunately it is. But the memories we have! By mid-morning, transfer to the Anchorage airport for our return flight home. **What an incredible 10 days!** *(Bkfst)*
